WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM (WEP)

TENT-TUITION PROGRAM

"Tuition for Tent Children" is an educational program aimed at providing schooling for children living in temporary or precarious shelters, such as tents or refugee camps. Often displaced by disasters, conflicts, or poverty, these children face interruptions in their education and lack access to resources. The program focuses on bridging educational gaps, helping children reintegrate into formal schooling, and fostering resilience. Core subjects like language, math, and science are taught in age-appropriate ways, addressing missed school time. Additionally, the program includes psychosocial support to help children cope with trauma, promoting both educational progress and emotional well-being.



TUITION FOR SLUM CHILDREN

"Tuition for slum children" is an educational program aimed at supporting children in impoverished urban areas who face educational challenges due to poverty and lack of resources. By offering extra classes in subjects like mathematics, language, and science, the program bridges gaps in their learning and helps them keep up with peers from more privileged backgrounds. Through small group sessions and personalized attention, children receive individualized support, building confidence and enabling them to succeed academically and improve their future prospects.



NAVAJEEVAN holistic & palliative CARE CENTRE (NHPC)

The Malnad Social Service Society (MSSS) launched a community care program over a decade ago to improve the lives of people with HIV/AIDS. This initiative combines medical treatment with social support, addressing the emotional and social needs of those affected. By fostering community-driven responses, MSSS raises awareness to reduce stigma and discrimination, encouraging acceptance and empathy. This holistic approach promotes both healthcare and social inclusion, offering a sustainable, dignified solution for individuals living with HIV/AIDS.



MAZDOOR SURAKSHA YOJANA (MSY)

The Mazdoor Suraksha Yojana (MSY), launched by the Workers India Federation and the Catholic Bishops Conference's Labor Commission, aims to support unorganized workers, especially in agriculture, self-employment, and daily wage labor. MSY provides a financial safety net, focusing on retirement security through a government-aligned pension scheme. With a yearly subsidy of Rs. 1000, it encourages savings among low-income workers. Over 543 participants have enrolled, highlighting MSY's success in promoting economic security and social protection for vulnerable workers across India.



SPARSHA - CAMPAIGN AGAINST CANCER

The SPARSHA campaign, led by Caritas India, highlights the transformative power of human touch, offering hope and emotional support alongside medical care to cancer patients. Focused on raising awareness in Shimoga and Chikmagalur, SPARSHA dispels myths, encourages early cancer detection, and emphasizes screenings for breast and cervical cancers. By promoting healthier lifestyles, organic farming, and reducing cancer risk factors, the campaign seeks to prevent cancer through education. Led by the Diocese of Bhadravathi, it also shares survivor stories to inspire resilience and confidence among patients.
